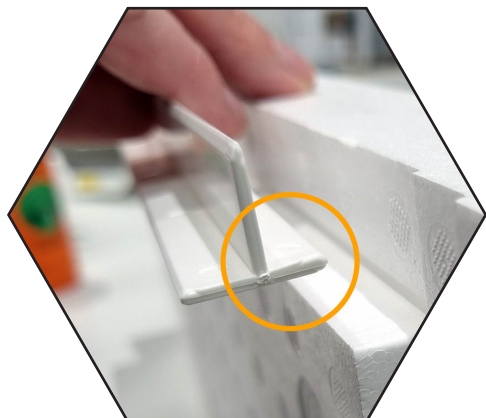
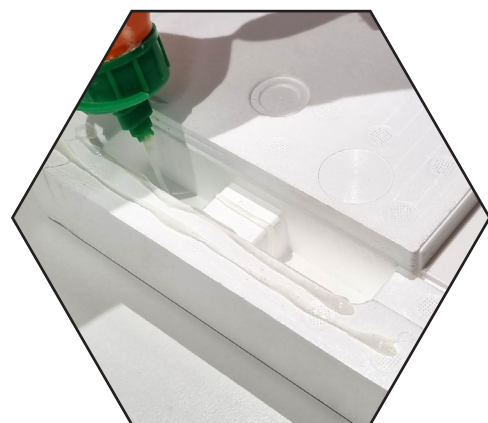


Hive Body assembly



1. Push the plastic strips into the grooves on the end pieces of the hive. One edge is thicker and that is supposed to go inside the groove.

2. Add PU glue, Cascol for example. Don't use too much glue, just enough to cover all joint surfaces.



3. Moisten the surface with a slight spray of water. The moisture activates the glue.

4. Assemble the box. Push the parts together and tap them with a hand to make sure the joints are tight.



5. After the glue has dried, cut off the excess glue. If desired, the hive can be painted. Painting improves the weather resistance and makes cleaning easier. Before painting the whole body, apply a test paint to a small area just to make sure the polystyrene doesn't react with the paint. Do not paint the inner surfaces!
