

POLLEN TRAP ASSEMBLY - HOW TO DO IT

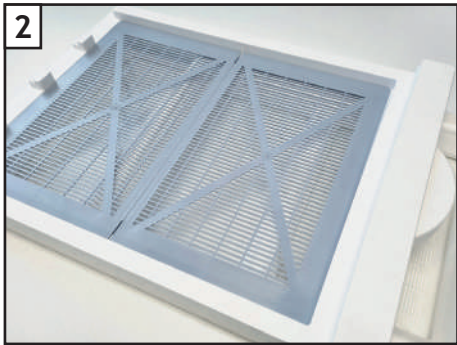
i Note: Pollen Trap requires our Ventilation Bottom.



1. Flip the pollen tray upside down and glue the white mesh underneath

2. Connect the trash collector meshes and glue it to the trap body.

3. Connect the four collector meshes as shown in the photos below. Place them on top of the collector body and screw the meshes in place.



The red mesh pieces are installed two pieces side by side in two layers. The mesh pieces have pins and slots underneath and they fit together easily. Also the sides have pins and slots to secure the joint.

4. Fasten the red mesh to the trap body using eight screws provided. Do not overtighten.



5. Cut seven equal stubs from the hose. Appropriate length is ca. 35-40 mm. Insert the hose stubs into the entrance block holes. Use some glue to secure the fastening.

6. If desired, paint the Pollen Trap's exterior surfaces.

HOW DOES IT WORK

1. The bees fly inside underneath the entrance block.

2. While crawling through the collector meshes, the pollen drops down through the trash collector.

3. Bees move outside through the hoses. They are not able to entry through them.

4. The pollen is collected by opening the tray from behind the hive.
